#### John Shaw Neilson - 1872-1942



John Shaw Neilson is regarded as Australia's greatest lyric Poet,he lived in Footscray and worked at a local bluestone quarry,his accounts of the hardships experienced by local labourers highlights the tough conditions under which quarrymen operated. Called "The poor working man who has left us a legacy of endless wealth".

#### **Clair Saxby - Author**




Clair is an Author of Books and Poetry for Children and recent publications include: Big Red Kangaroo and Meet the Anzacs.
